She was appointed by the Provincial Council as the Party's treasurer in 2018. She was elected as the Interior Regional Representative in 2015 and 2017, and Member at Large in 2019 and 2021.

In 2018, Barb made history by becoming the first woman elected President of the Hospital Employees' Union. In this role, Barb rose to the challenge of protecting the safety and collective agreement rights of 50,000 frontline healthcare workers through this global pandemic. Her leadership and advocacy ensured these essential workers received the support and protections they deserved during an unprecedented crisis.

As the former President of the Kamloops and District Labour Council, Barb paved the way for a long and proud history of standing up for health care, seniors care, workers' rights and family-supporting jobs, human rights, and poverty elimination initiatives.

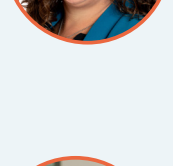

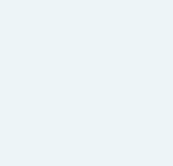
