In 2004, Lunny joined USW after the IWA merger. He worked as a staff representative and key member, focusing on forest policy and legislative campaigns. As a long-time political activist and social democrat, Lunny served five years as Vice-President of the BC NDP and has been active with Steelworkers Vote and lobbying campaigns for the USW. He is actively involved in his community, serving as President of the Union Protein Project, aiding food banks and advocating for food security. He also coaches youth baseball and volunteers in local programs.

Scott looks forward to taking on the role of Member at Large (Labour), driven by his unwavering commitment to advocate for workers' rights, champion social justice, and advance equity in our party.
